PART 1 (4–5 mins)

Frame 1

Let's talk about what you do.

- Do you work or are you a student?
- What do you find most interesting about your job/studies? (Why?)
- Will you continue to do this job in the future?
 What will you do when you finish your studies? (Why/Why not?)

Frame 2

Let's talk about dancing.

- Do you enjoy dancing? (Why/Why not?)
- Has anyone ever taught you to dance? (Why/Why not?)
- Is dancing a part of traditional culture in your country? (Why/Why not?)
- Do you think that traditional dancing will be popular in the future? (Why/Why not?)

Frame 3

Let's talk about flowers now.

- Do you like flowers? (Why/Why not?)
- What's your favourite flower? (Why?)
- Do any flowers have special meaning in your country? (Why?)
- Why do you think women like flowers more than men? (Why?)



Part 2 (3-4 mins)

I'd like you to describe a person in your family that you like.

Describe a person in your family that you like.

You should say:

- how this person is related to you
- what this person looks like
- what kind of person he/she is

and explain why you like this person.

Have you seen this person recently?



PART 3 (4 – 5 mins)

Frame 1

- Family similarities
 - In what ways can people in a family be similar to each other?
 - Do you think that sons are always more similar to fathers than to female relatives?
 - In terms of personality, do you think people are more influenced by their family members or by their friends?

Frame 2:

- Genetic research
 - How do people in your country feel about genetic research?
 - Where can people in your country get information about genetic research?
 - Do you think genetic research should be funded by governments or by private companies?
